6. Responsibly collect and dispose of all batteries at the end of their working life .

7. Donate computer equipment for reuse (hard drives will be security wiped before disposal)

Transportation

The Commercial Photographers Network will:

1. Reduce the need to travel, restricting it to necessary trips only.

2. Promote the use of travel alternatives such as e-mail or video/phone conferencing.

3. Utilise public transport wherever possible.

Culture The Commercial Photographers Network Ltd will:

1. Involve members in the implementation of this policy, for greater commitment and improved performance.

2. Periodically update this policy in consultation with staff and other stakeholders.

3. Provide members with relevant environmental training.

4. Work with suppliers and customers to help minimise the impact of their operations wherever possible.

5. Wherever practicable make use of and contribute to local resources and communities.
